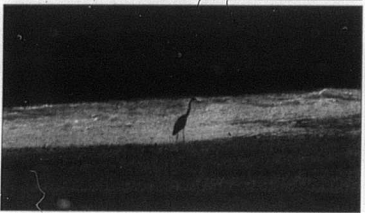

Many homeowners at Carmco put a sign to have sewage holding tanks pumped out on a regular basis. "It's expensive," said one homeowner, "but the real problem is the inconvenience of it all. You feel that you must use water sparingly because you know that you have to deal with the resulting wastewater whether it is kitchen or bathroom wastewater or just the water from the washing machine."

Because the \$1.4 million that is already available is insufficient to construct sewer lines for all of the approximately 100 homes around the lake, there seemed to be a consensus to complete the engineering design work for sewer lines to push forward with the construction of the Lake Carmco lowest cost per customer ratio.
