FOR GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
OF 2010 ON MOTOR VEHICLES AND WATERCRAFT WITHIN
THE EXISTING JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF CARLISLE. SHALL
BE THE RATE OF \$2.347 PER ONE HUNDRED (\$100) DOLLARS OF
THE ASSESSED VALUATION.
Be it ordained by the City of Carlisle:
Section 1. That for the purpose of general support of the government
of the City of Carlisle, and the payment of its debts, the calendar year
of 2010, there be and hereby are levied ad valorem taxes on
each one hundred (\$100) dollars of the assessed value of all motor
vehicles and watercraft within the existing jurisdiction of the City of Carlisle
which shall be at the rate of \$2.347.
Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication
in full as required by law, with an effective date of July 1, 2010.
